In September 2024 our evangelism team saw 52 people come to Christ in San Viciente de La Lacas and Ungal Grande, near Riobamba, Ecuador. Billy Windham, another Nurse Practitioner and I were out witnessing on a break from doing medicine. We came up on John and Jane Howell and their translator, Daisy. She had translated the gospel presentation several times in the last three days. I sensed the Holy Spirit leading me to ask her, "Daisy, what is your relationship with Jesus Christ?" She gave honest, sincere responses, but had no personal relationship with Christ. Again, I walked her down the Roman Road, and the Holy Spirit made it wonderfully clear that she needed to repent and put her faith alone in Christ for salvation. On the roadside we all prayed and rejoiced with her in Christ.
